## **Our Commitment to parents**

Horn End welcomes all children whatever their individual needs and believes in providing an inclusive setting

We believe that all children have a right to a broad and balanced Early Years Curriculum  
We aim to identify any difficulties a child might have and to work with parents, carers and where necessary other agencies to address those difficulties

We will respect parental wishes and take into account the views choices and responses of the child where possible

We will obtain parental consent before contacting another professional  
(Unless there are concerns of child protection)

## **Accessibility and facilities**

Our premises is suitable for wheelchair access

We have a discrete nappy changing area

Our outdoor play area comprises a variety of surfaces, grass, bark, and concrete

If it is felt we require additional support for a child we will contact agencies as necessary

## **We provide an inclusive environment**

We plan long, medium, and in short term to ensure we provide activities to enable progress of those children with special educational needs

Differentiating our activities so that children can access equipment as needed to gain success and confidence

We aim to meet children's individual needs through providing quality resources and through adapting our approach and providing appropriate materials

Observation notebooks and record keeping is kept in conjunction with parent liaison, this enables us to monitor progress. We operate a key worker system to address individual needs

Our SENCO is supported to obtain appropriate training, and translate to colleagues as necessary

We provide areas in all rooms to provide opportunities for individual and group play

## **Code of Practice**

Our setting aims to have regard to the DFES code of practice (November 2001)

We provide a graduated response to the early identification and assessment of SEN as recommended by the code of practice

Children's progress in relation to IEP targets and support received will be reviewed at least three times annually

Our work with children and their families confidential information to be disclosed. The disclosure of any confidential information will be treated with professionalism and respect.
