Effective hygiene is very important to us at Horn End. Did you know hand washing is the single most important method of reducing the spread of infection? We have been working hard to promote effective hand washing throughout nursery. Our aim has been to introduce a repetitious routine which is consistent in each room so that it becomes habit for your child.

Our routine goes as follows:-

Wet hands, Squirt Soap, Make bubbles.

Then palm to palm, right then left, in between the fingers too

Hands together under the tap, rinse off soap.

Dry hands then clean hands

FLOOD DEFENCES

These are now complete and we are confident that the nursery will remain watertight in future. The front gate will be used every evening and weekend and creates a seal to our perimeter wall which is already fully waterproof. For additional protection each doorway then has purpose made barriers which are installed as necessary and at weekends. Every drain has been investigated with one way valves put on where required. We have carried out all the above in consultation with Severn Trent Water and a flood specialist company based in Worcester.
